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Question #5: The contract provided is for General Construction projects, so many of the sections are not relevant to a loose furniture project (i.e. Subcontractor Listings, Sub-surface Conditions, Inspections, Testing, Sampling, DSA, Submittals, Schedule of Values, Payment Applications, Retention, Shop Drawings, As Built Drawings, Contract schedule Development. Additional Submissions - DSA-6 Final Verified Reports, etc.)

Response #5: All items that apply to the project, such as Submittals, will apply. Other items that do not apply, such as Sub-surface Conditions, Testing, Sampling, DSA reports, Schedule of Values, Payment Applications, and Retention, will not apply.

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Question #6: Instructions to Bidders 00 21 13 Section 1.10.D & Section 1.15 are typically required by a General Contractor on new or modernization type projects. Do these really apply to loose furniture?

Response #6: Section 1.10.D: A schedule will be required but the requirement for a CPM schedule can be waived. Time and Materials wage sheet and Matrix of submittals are required. A schedule of values is not required. Section 1.15: Subcontractor listing is required.
