RESOLUTION NO. 2907

"RECOGNITION OF OCTOBER AS NATIONAL DYSLEXIA MONTH"

WHEREAS, Sacramento City Unified School District (SCUSD) recognizes that our children are our most valuable resourced we must provide opportunities to learn and grow; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Health defines dyslexia as an inheritable and highly prevalent language based disability affecting 1 in 5 individuals, including 8,635 students enrolled in general and specification classrooms in SCUSD; and

WHEREAS, dyslexia is a specific learning disability that is neurobiological in origin characterized by difficulties with accurate and fluent word recognition, poor spelling, and decoding abilities, typically resulting of a deficit in phonological processing, and is often

WHEREAS, early diagnosis of dyslexia is critical for ensuring that individuals with dyslexia receive focused, evidentizesed intervention by highly qualifical instructors that includes appropriate education, necessary accommodations, and the promotion and selfempowerment so as to ensure school and life success; and

WHEREAS, with proper identification, appropriate instruction, accommodation, access to assistive technologies, and support from families, teachers and friends, individuals with dyslexia can excel in school and employment; and

WHEREAS, a concerted effort to educate and empower students, families and educators is critical to promte meaningful literacy development with the goal of preparing individuals

cognitive and emotional strengths typical of people with dyslexia, in order to ensure the success for every student with dyslexia enlied in the District; and be it

THEREFORE, NOW BE IT RESOLVED that the Superintendent transmits copies of this resolution to its teachers, staff, departments and schools for appropriate distribution and implementation.
