What is the Consolidated Application?

The Consolidated Application (ConApp) is used by the California Department of Education (CDE) to distribute categorical funds from various state and federal programs to county offices, school districts, and direct-funded charter schools and to collect data.

The Consolidated Application is completed in three parts:

<u>Part 1: Spring Release</u> May-June: Submitted by the District to document participation in categorical programs and provide assurances that the district will comply with the legal requirements of each program. Part I is approved by School Board and DAC. Program entitlements are determined by formulas contained in the laws that created the programs.

Fall Release is submitted in October of each year. This will be an opportunity for the various CDE
