Every local educational agency (LEA), including a Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) agency, is required to submit a 3-year plan to the state.

This process includes a public hearing / advisory committee (PAC). A community advisory board (CAB) is also being established to provide input to the LCAP process.

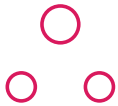
