Sexual Harassment Reporting: Acknowledgement of Receipt and Agreement to Comply

Sexual harassment violates federal and state law as well as the Sacramento City Unified School District's Board Policy.

By definition, "*sexual harassment consists of unwelcome sexual advances, requests for sexual favors, and other verbal or physical conduct of a sexual nature when made by a member of the school staff to a student or to another staff member, or when made by a student to another student . . .*" (Board Policy BP/AR 4119.11)
